This past week I was able to secure the hotel and I'll be reviewing the final contract version (4th) and signing next week. We have a real good deal on the Hotel next year, with a room rate of \$125 which includes breakfast for two and really nice rooms. I have not actually seen them yet but planning on going out later this year to review.

The Hotel has included the normal 3 nights before and after the reunion at the same rate, so I encourage you to extend your trip to see more of the area. If there is enough interest, we can schedule a golf outing as we have in the past on Tuesday or Wednesday morning. There are several historic tours geared for small groups you can take advantage of.
